

INTRODUCTION

The pandemic inspired innovation that has carried businesses through a global crisis.

While we've made significant progress, 75% of IT leaders surveyed in our Work Wins IT leadership report said they still feel like they are reacting to problems, rather than innovating. At the same time, they are being asked to lead the charge in transformative organizational change.

So, how can IT empower dispersed teams to collaborate and perform their best?

WHAT IS A CHIEF FOCUS OFFICER?

The Chief Focus Officer will be responsible for giving workers easy-to-use, enterprise-grade collaboration tools that seamlessly flex between two modes of working: home and office.

They will review technology needs for the workforce as a whole, taking into consideration personal preferences and expectations. Because a one-size-fits-all approach won't serve every need within the organization, they'll curate a mixture of resources that does.

THE CHIEF FOCUS OFFICER WILL PRIORITIZE:

Simplifying the complex:

They will be responsible for standardizing solutions that meet compliance requirements and perform reliably with the aim to reduce compliance issues and moderate the number of support requests IT receive.

Curating IT:

They will need to prioritize solutions that strike a balance between giving users enough choice to pick the right solution for their specific needs and function, but not so many options that they go into analysis paralysis. In doing this, they'll consider how employees in different roles will have different preferences and needs.
